RULES & INFORMATION

BUY-IN: **\$3,200 + \$300** STARTING CHIPS: **50,000**

ACTION CLOCK:

The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used after level 16 on Day 2. See WPT Action Clock Rules for more details. Time extension chips will accumulate and not be reset.

ANTE FORMAT (BIG BLIND ANTE):

Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. Ante is posted before the big blind and players are eligible to collect the entire ante, even when out of the big blind. Ante is maintained until the completion of the tournament.

BREAKS:

Players will have a 15-minute break every two levels on Day 1 and a 90-minute dinner break after Level 6.
 Players will have a 15-minute break every two levels on Day 2 and a 90-minute dinner break after Level 16.
 Players will have a 15-minute break after every level when 90-minute levels begin.

BUY-IN & FEES:

\$3,200 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$300 is a registration fee of which \$100 will go towards staffing.

LATE REGISTRATION:

On-Site Registration and unlimited re-entry per day are available until the start of Level 9. No Refunds.

LEVELS, PER DAY:

Day 1 & Day 2 levels will last 60 minutes each.
 Day 3 Levels will be 60 minutes until 40 players remain, then go to 90 minute levels.
 Day 4 Levels will be 90 minutes until players reach the Final Table of 6.
 Final Table Levels will be 60 minutes & 30 minutes Heads-Up.

PAYOUTS:

One in eight (1-in-8) entries will be in the money (approximately 12.5%). Winners must show valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries will be subject to withholding, per casino policy.
 \$10,400 will be withheld from the prize pool and issued to 1st Place in the form of an entry to the WPT World Championship held in Las Vegas in December, 2026.

PLAYERS PER TABLE:

Tables will be 9-Handed at the start of the event and 8-Handed at start of Day 3.

PLAYER'S CARD AND PLAYER RELEASE:

In order to play in the event, each player must sign the mandatory WPT Player Release Form. Players must be at least 18 years old with proper ID and a Unity Card to play the event.

RE-ENTRY:

If player entered into any starting day and has been eliminated from tournament, player may re-enter or register for subsequent starting day. Players may not bag and play a subsequent flight. Players may forfeit their stack to re-enter or participate in subsequent starting day.

RULES:

Tournament Director Association (TDA) rules will be used, unless House Rules apply. Please, see tournament staff for House Rules. Participation in WPT tournaments is subject to rules and rulings set forth by the applicable venue(s) and/or WPT (e.g., tournament rules, sponsors). Tournament Director's decisions are final. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities. Time extension chips are considered tournament chips.

SEATING REDRAWS:

A redraw will occur at the end of Day 1 & 2. Players will also redraw at 24, 16, and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.

STARTING STACK:

50,000 tournament chips. Pre-purchased stacks will be "live" on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Late registrants and alternates will be sold a full starting stack. This is a five-day tournament with two starting days.

WPT PLAYER OF THE YEAR:

The WPT Main Tour Events are eligible for the WPT Player of the Year race.

ACTION CLOCK RULES

- The Action Clock will be implemented into play after Level 16. While the Action Clock is in play, players must keep chips in stacks of 20, whenever possible.
- The Action Clock will be controlled by the dealer. Dealers will start the Action Clock following the completion of each deal once the last card has been dealt. When players act in turn, the Action Clock will be reset, with each player receiving a fresh clock to begin their action, as outlined below.

WPT Main Tour	Pre-Flop	Post-Flop
Day 2 (after Level 16)	15 seconds	30 seconds
Day 3	20 seconds	30 seconds
Day 4	20 seconds	30 seconds
Day 5 (final 6 players)	30 seconds	30 seconds

- When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will first count the bet or raise size, announce the amount, and then start the clock for the next action. If a player calls the bet, the dealer will reset the clock to begin the next player's action.
- Pre-Flop: for a player's initial pre-flop action they will receive 15, 20, or 30 seconds, per the table listed above. For any additional pre-flop action (e.g., facing a 3-bet), the player will receive 30 seconds to make their follow-up decision.
- When players receive 15 or 20 seconds to act, dealers will **not** advise players when the Action Clock reaches 10 seconds.
- When players receive 30 seconds to act, dealers **will** advise players when the Action Clock reaches 10 seconds.
- To begin play in the Action Clock portion of the tournament, each player will receive time-extension chips. Each time-extension chip is worth a 30-second addition to a player's action.

- Players are required to keep their remaining time-extension chips visible at all times.
- At the conclusion of play each day, any unused time extension chips will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and will carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification. If a player does not use any of their time chips and reaches the final table, they will be limited to a maximum of 20 time extension chips.
- If a player voluntarily passes forward all of the time extensions the full amount of time will be added to the clock and the time extensions will not be returned if all of the time is not used.
- In the case that the Action Clock expires for a player with remaining time-extension chips, the player's Action Clock will be automatically extended an additional 30 seconds before the dealer collects the time-extension chip(s) used. Collection will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's Action Clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, they will be (a) forced to check if there is no bet pending or (b) fold if facing a bet or a raise.
- The Action Clock will never be paused unless there is an extreme situation that calls for play to be halted.
- Tournament play will transition to eight-handed play once 10 tables remain.

Buy-in: \$300 (\$250 prize pool + \$50 registration fee)

Starting Chips: 40,000

ACTION CLOCKS:

The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used for the entire duration of the tournament. The Action Clock is 15 seconds to act for both pre and post flop. Players will get six (6) time extension chips when entering the tournament. The final nine (9) players will get an additional six (6) time extension chips. Players with time extensions are not responsible for throwing in time extension chips during their decisions, they will be collected at the end of the street or hand. If a player puts in multiple time extensions during play the dealer will add 30 seconds for each chip thrown forward. Players are not entitled to a refund of unused time chips if multiple thrown forward and full time not used. See WPT Action Clock Rules for more details.

ANTE FORMAT (BIG BLIND ANTE):

Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. The big blind is before the ante when a player has less than a big blind and ante amount, per new TDA recommendations.

BREAKS:

Players will have a 15-minute break after Level 6, Level 9, Level 14, and Level 19.

LATE REGISTRATION:

On-Site Registration and re-entry per open until the start of Level 10.

LEVELS:

20-minute levels.

PAYOUTS:

One in eight (1-in-8) entries will be in the money (approximately 12.5%). Winners must show valid ID to collect winnings.

RE-ENTRY:

Unlimited re-entries.

RULES:

Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules will be used, unless House Rules apply. Please, see tournament staff for House Rules. Participation in WPT tournaments is subject to rules and rulings set forth by the applicable venue(s) and/or WPT (e.g., tournament rules, sponsors). Tournament Director's decisions are final.
