### Rules and Information

BUY-IN: **\$200**      GUARANTEE: **\$15,000**

1. TDA rules apply to all poker tournaments at The Lodge Card Club.
2. Must be 18+ years of age and have an active club membership to participate.
3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of every two (2) hours of play.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change the tournament.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. Players start with 25,000 in chips. The first twelve (12) levels will be 20 minutes, all remaining levels will be 30 minutes.
7. \$157 of the \$200 buy-in will be added to the total prize pool. \$43 of the \$200 buy-in will be withheld as fees.
8. In the event a player has won a buy-in or a satellite that rewarded "Tournament Entry Lammers", players may use the lammers in increments of \$100 and any odd value must be made up in cash.
9. ALL DEUCES ARE WILD CARDS AND CAN BE USED AS ANY CARD IN THE DECK. HOWEVER, NO HAND CAN HAVE TWO (2) CARDS WITH THE SAME RANK AND SUIT WHEN USING A WILD CARD.
10. Atypical Hand rankings exist in Deuces Wild. The hands below are in descending order:  
Natural Royal Flush, 5 of a Kind, Wild Royal Flush, Natural Straight Flush, Wild Straight Flush, Natural Four of a Kind, Wild 4 of a Kind. All remaining hands are ranked as normal regardless of the presence of wild cards in the hand.
11. Late entry and reentry will be allowed until the beginning of the eighth (8th) level.
12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
13. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.

- Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
