Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. The big blind comes before the ante when a player has less than a big blind and ante amount, per new TDA recommendations.

BUY-IN & FEES:

USD 1,500 + USD 150.

Registration closes at the start of Level 11.

Single ante will be posted by all players. The dealer will collect all Antes and proceed to deal hole cards and the flop before any further betting.

9. When breaking a table, a player must keep their time extensions and tournament chips in plain view while traveling to their new seat.
10. Each time extension will add an additional thirty (30) seconds to act.
11. Players will receive time extension chips at predetermined stages (set level or remaining number of players) as outlined on the structure sheet.
12. Players are required to keep all time extension chips visible and on the table at all times.
13. Players will automatically lose one (1) time extension each time the Action Clock reaches zero (0), and will be instructed by the dealer to turn in the corresponding amount of time extensions used at the completion of their action. Players are not responsible for placing a time extension chip into the pot in real time.
14. In the event that a player does not have any time extensions remaining and the Action Clock reached zero (0), the player's hand will be declared dead (or the player will be forced to check if facing no action).
15. Once implemented, the Tournament Action Clock will be used until the completion of the event and will not be suspended.
16. At the conclusion of play each day, any unused time extension chips will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and will carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification.

ACTION CLOCK TIME TO ACT:

Refer to schedule and/or structure pages. Time extension period always equals the initial time to act.

NUMBER OF TIME EXTENSION CHIPS:

- 5/5/5, 10/10/10 or 20/20/20 events – 0 time extension chips
- Satellites up to 12 minute levels – 2 time extension chips at start.
- Satellites 15 minute levels plus – 3 time extension chips at start
- One Day Side events up to 20 minute levels – 3 time extension chips at start, reset at final table
- One Day Side events 25 minute levels plus – 4 time extension chips at start, reset at final table
- Multi Day 1 side events – 4 time extension chips at start, +3 start Day 2 and at final table
- Single Day \$1,650+ Buyin events up to 20 minute levels – 3 time extension chips at start, +3 at final table
- Single Day \$1,650+ Buyin events >20 minute levels – 4 time extension chips at start, +3 active players last hand of reg, +3 at final table
- Two Day \$1,650+ Buyin events (reg closes Day 1) – 4 time extension chips at start, +4 active players last hand of reg, +4 at final table
- Two Day \$1,650+ Buyin events (reg closes Day 2) – 5 time extension chips at start, +3 end Day 1, +3 24 players after reg closes (if applicable), +3 at final table
- Championship Event – 4 time extension chips at start of Day 2, +4 first break after ITM, + 4 3 tables remaining, +4 at final table.

ACTION CLOCK RULES

1. Dealers will initiate the start of the Tournament Action Clock upon the completion of the deal. Time will begin for a player once the natural flow of play has come to a brief pause pending their action and be reset to the corresponding time for the next player to act
2. When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will count and announce the bet or raise (including All In bets) prior to starting the Action Clock for the next player
3. To facilitate the smooth operation of the tournament, all tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips, when available
4. When breaking a table, a player must keep their time extensions and tournament chips in plain view while traveling to their new seat
5. Players will receive time extension chips at predetermined stages (set level or remaining number of players) as outlined on the structure sheet
6. Players are required to keep all time extension chips visible and on the table at all time
7.
